Rules and Requirements

1. Maximum song length is 3-4 minutes.
2. The Youth Music Competition is a solo competition. Duets, trios, etc., are not permitted.
3. Pre-recorded accompaniment is not allowed. Performers must have either live accompaniment or be unaccompanied. Competitors arrange for their own accompaniment.
4. Bring three photocopies of the music you will perform to your audition. The copies will be destroyed after your performance.
5. Attach to your application a short biography of 100 words or less, including whether the student applicant is part of a performing group in school or in the community.
6. A student can win only ONCE in any level. Once they win in a level, they must wait until they are in the next level to compete again.
7. A student may not compete the year immediately following their win, even if they switch levels. For example, a student winning in the last year of middle school eligibility may not compete in the high school level the following year.
8. The Community Club will open one hour before competition begins. If you need to use the clubhouse piano to warm up, it will be available ONLY during that one hour, and each contestant will be limited to 10 minutes of warm-up time. No warm-ups will be allowed in the green room once the competition has begun!
9. Approximately three days prior to the competition, each applicant will receive notification as to the performance time for their age group. Students are advised to arrive at least 15 minutes prior to the 6PM start time and to support other performers until the end of the competition. The performance order will be drawn at random prior to the beginning of each age group.
